Issue description	Raised by Transport for Greater Manchester The historic limit for a registration number has been 4 characters. With the advent of Enhanced Partnership developed registration authorities requirements from the Bus Open Data Service meant that the advice in the following profile document: https://www.pti.org.uk/system/files/files/TransXChange%20UK%20PTI%20Profile%20-20-%20Service%20Codes%20in%20Enhanced%20Partnerships%20Application%20Note%20V1.0.pdf expects that the registration number for devolved registrations is an 8 character reference. This means that the TransXChange schema no longer matches the guidance.
Issue manifestation	A registration management system that is coded to check validity against the schema including constraints in documentation tags within the XSD files will not allow a registration code greater than 4 characters.
Issue severity	High

Response options	Update the document tag in TransXChange TXC_registration-v2-4-a to reflect that the number of characters is increased from 4 to 8.
